Sustainability at Massanutten

Over the past year and a half, we have become more **dedicated to addressing our impact on the environment**. We are proud of our efforts so far, but we are far from done. Kicking off our 51st year, we are so fortunate to have more opportunities to **engage with the community** and each other as our **sustainability efforts continue to grow**.



Massanutten Resort's Sustainability Committee has set a goal to reduce our **2021 carbon emissions 15% by 2025**. To do this, a major focus is on emission reduction projects, advocacy, and education. It is important to us that we are transparent in our efforts. As owners, you deserve to be updated with progress. Below is a brief update on our **solar energy** and our **advocacy efforts**.

Our third, and largest, solar project is nearing completion! While the **Woodstone and Laundry Building** arrays have been producing energy for almost a year, focus has shifted to the **WaterPark's 2,700 panel array** that is under construction. There has been a delay in getting some parts, but this project should be complete and producing energy by late Fall 2023!

In addition to our projects on the Resort, this summer we have been doing more direct

advocacy and education. Some of the projects include hosting a field trip for a middle school renewable energy summer camp, joining over 70 businesses in talking with congress about transitioning to a clean economy, and launching a sustainability video series called **That's So Sus**. Tips for Timeshare Owners

Owner Gold Card Discounts and why it brings value to your Ownership!

When you purchase your timeshare from Massanutten – Owners are golden because your ownership provides many benefits and discounts. **Gold Card Owners** and their legal dependents (as defined by IRS) are entitled to discounts on the Massanutten WaterPark, golf, skiing/snowboarding, and many more activities and attractions at Massanutten. You must present a valid **Gold Card** for each discounted ticket. View the full list of discounts [here](#). NEW to the Gold Card discounts are the scenic chairlift rides and TopGolf Swing Suite rentals at Perfect Break.

In order to receive your **Owner Gold Card Discounts** in advance, you will need to login to your [Owner's Website](#). You are still able to make in-person purchases however, you may find fewer items available for purchase compared to purchasing in advance. **Tickets may sell out, especially during holidays and weekends.**

Remember, a valid **Gold Card ID** will be required for each ticket purchased with the discount at time of redemption. For items purchased at non-Gold Card rate, owners **MUST** show their physical **Gold Card** at the ticket window to receive a refund for the price difference. **Gold Card** holders who have not had a photo ID card made in five or more years should stop by the ID Center at the Market at Massanutten Station, for a new card.
